Academy Autobiography Essay

For Senior Chaplain Status



Essay requirements:

1. Autobiography Essay Subject - "Your Journey of Faith".
2. Must be 2,000 words
3. Must be typed
4. Must have date, first and last name, contact number, email address and essay title.
5. Must reference scripture
6. Must have a: Title, Body (state past, present and future) and a conclusion

Example of questions you may want to ask yourself when writing your essay body:

- I. What was your life like before you trusted Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord?
 - II. How did you come to accept Christ and give Him complete control of your life?
 - III. What happened after you trusted Christ?
7. Must contain repentance, forgiveness, conviction, humility and confession.
 8. Must be submitted prior to becoming Senior Chaplain by Messages of Faith Ministry.
 9. Send PDF of essay to: Chaplaincyacademy.edu1@gmail.com
 10. Bonus question: "what does faith in failure mean to you?"

The grade for this essay is **PASS** or **FAIL**. If you fail, you will be required to enter a spiritual refresher course and you will not be Senior Chaplain until the course has been completed and a new essay has been submitted.
