## **CPE:** Students have 2 choices of CPE to choose from -

**1.** Non Accredited- Certificate of Completion: 200 Total Hrs (In-house credits): No Fee Required Certificate of Completion offered by MOFM

## 2. Accredited Certification CPE Unit: 300 Total Hours: Fee Required

CPE is offered through APCC, LV Area authorized trainer and supervisor.

- <u>- Classroom hours</u> will include the MOFM/Chaplaincy Nevada study materials, lecturesand group activities plus an additional 15-30 minutes group time after each class with CPE Supervisor Benjamin for case study reviews and instruction/training on items specific to accreditation requirements.
- <u>- Clinical hours</u> include hospitals, hospices, clinical facilities, prisons/jails, law enforcement partnerships, church ministries and other approved mentorship / ministry programs.
